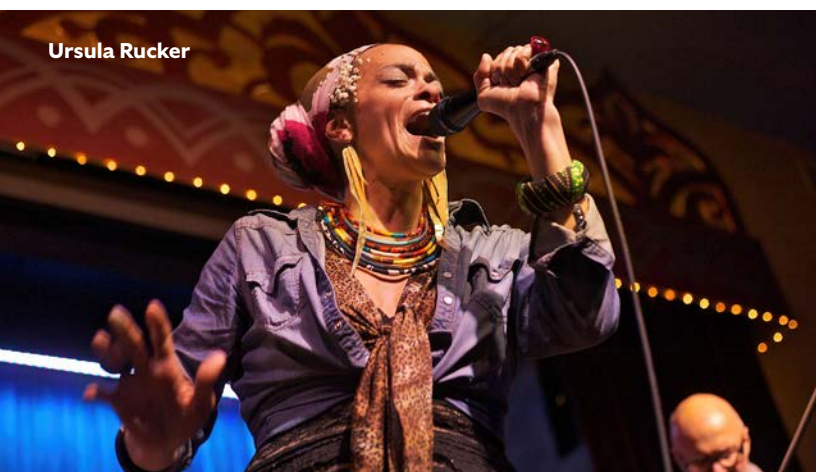

DIRECTIONS AND PARKING

UCLA NIMOY THEATER

The Nimoy is located on Westwood Boulevard at

1262 Westwood Boulevard
Los Angeles, CA 90024

Directions by car

From Wilshire Boulevard, turn south on Westwood Boulevard, and the theater is on the left before Wellworth Avenue.

PARKING AT THE NIMOY

Parking is located at 10866 Wilshire Boulevard. The entrance to the parking lot is on Glendon Avenue, directly to the left of the Los Angeles Public Library, Westwood Branch.

Enter through either of the two entrances marked "Visitor." Upon arrival, take a ticket from the automated booth, enter and park anywhere on the lot that is not marked "Reserved." You will need your ticket to exit, so please hold on to it. For performances that begin at 7 and 8 pm, you can enter the lot from 5 pm on. Parking in this lot costs \$3 during the designated time. Entering earlier than 5 pm will incur a \$30 day parking fee.

Patrons have the option to pay their ticket at the pay station before exiting the lot or pay at the exit gate.
